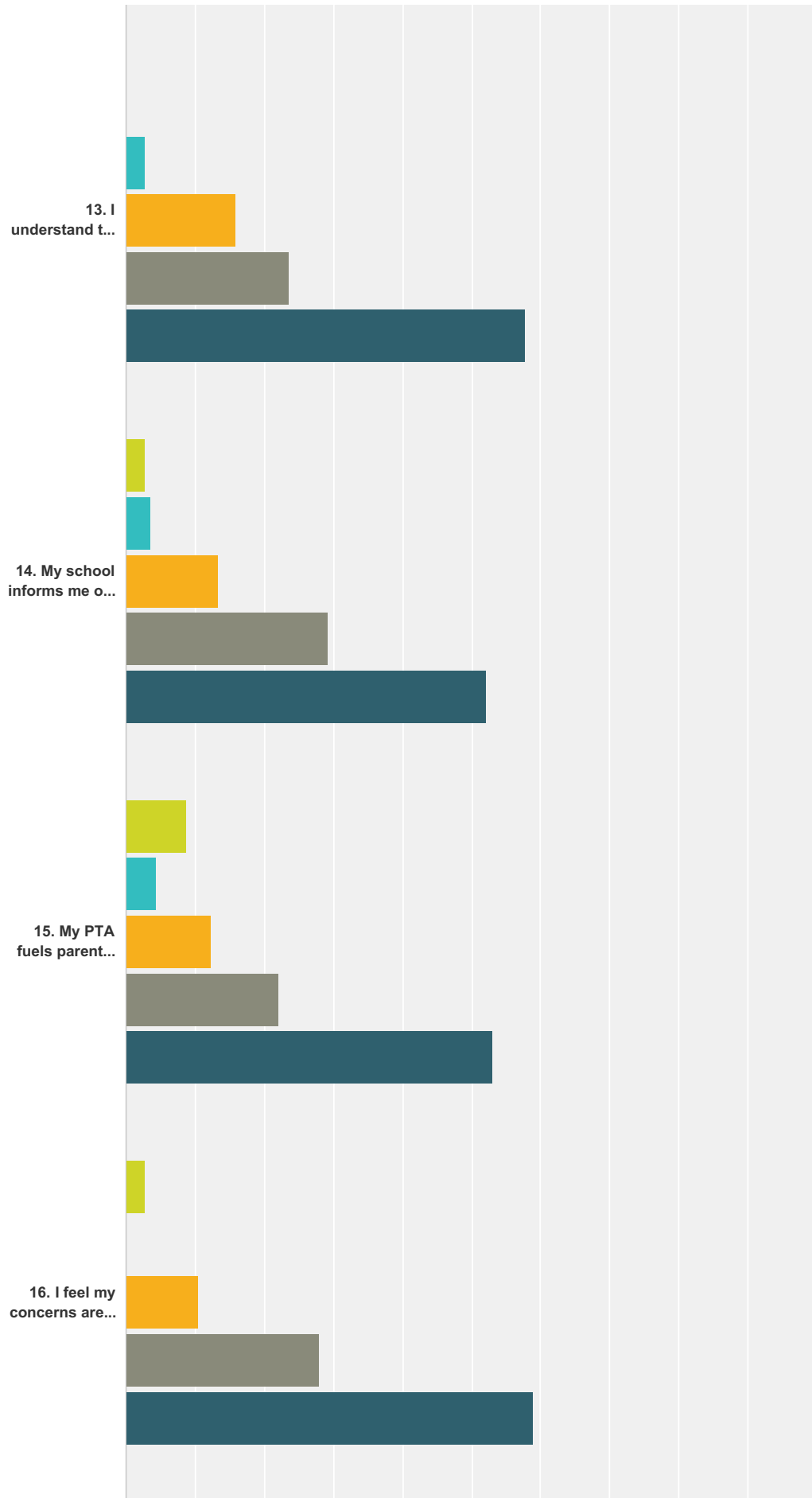
### Q2 Mark an "X" in the box that most accurately expresses how you feel about your experience.

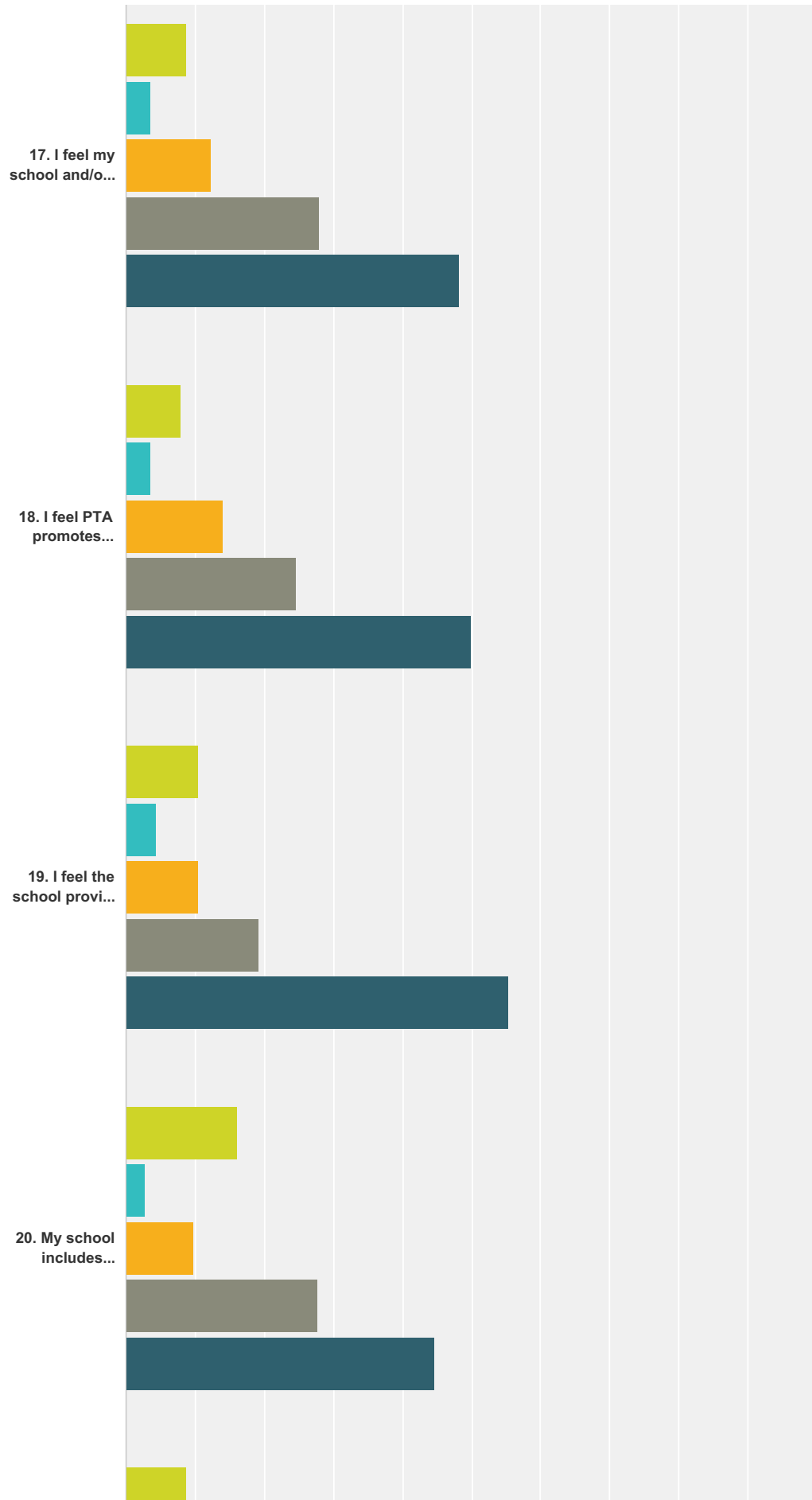

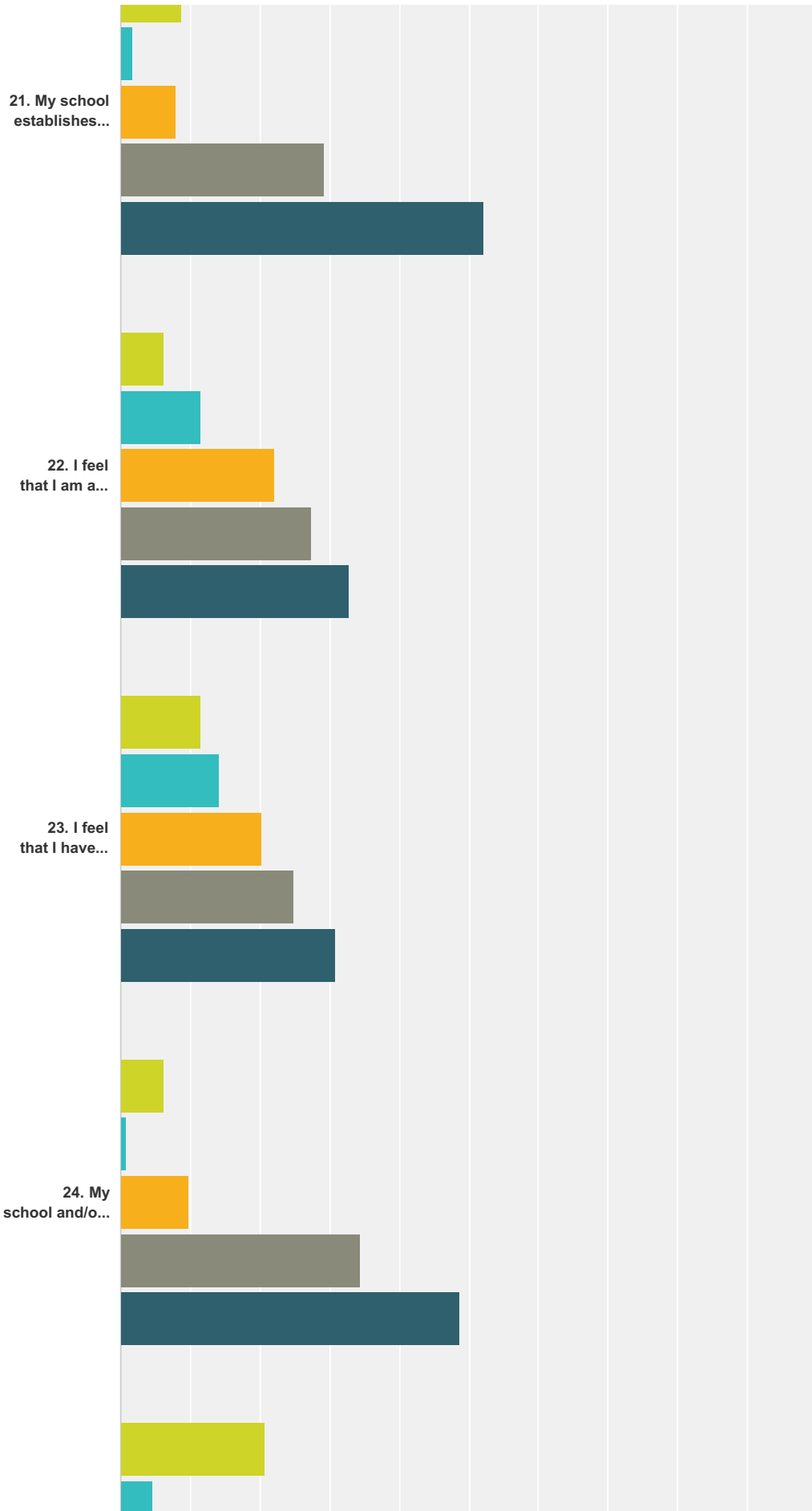


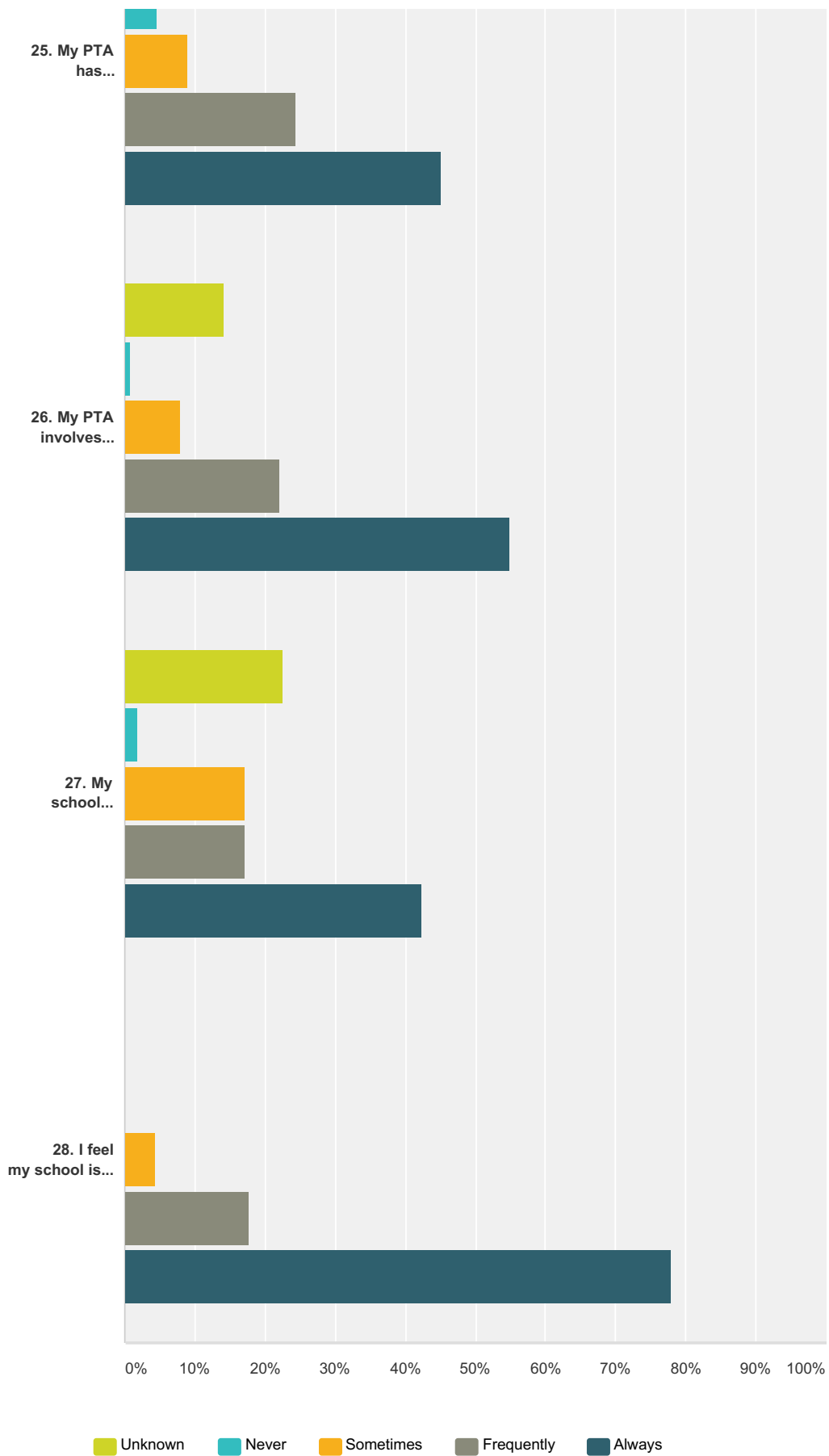
